




## Stryker Payouts to Begin for Defective Hip Implant Devices



Although Stryker Corporation voluntarily recalled its defective hip implant devices back in 2012, patients will begin to see the first settlement payouts from the recent lawsuit in the coming months. Stryker is offering [compensation for patients who needed hip implant revision surgery](#) to replace their defective Stryker devices, allowing victims to collect up to \$300,000 to cover surgery costs. Although the filing deadline to join the suit passed in March 2015, patients who underwent replacement surgery for a defective Rejuvenate Modular or ABG II hip implant before November 2014 are eligible for this

settlement. The company is also offering enhanced payments for patients who suffered greatly due to the device, and these payments will likely not be made until early 2016. Time to file a claim is limited, so find out if you qualify to [join the Stryker hip lawsuit](#) today!
